The second conditional is used to talk about unreal situations and their imaginary results. Complete the following sentences using appropriate second conditional forms of the verbs given in the brackets.

1. If he (start) early, he would finish in time.
2. If you worked harder, you (do) well on the test.
3. If I (be) you, I would accept that offer.
4. If she (know) who he was, she would not love him.
5. If I (be) you, I would not do it.
6. I (buy) a car if I got my raise.
7. If she flew to Canada, she (visit) her sister.
8. If she (try), she would succeed.
9. If you (ask) her, she would tell you.
10. She would hire you if she (think) you were qualified.
