that he be careful

Advise can be followed by to + be + adjective.

8. He promised us there at five.

to be

that he will be

that he would be

We use a that-clause after promise + object.

9. Nobody knows when arrive.

will he

he will

he would

In indirect questions, the auxiliary verb goes after the subject.

10. Tom could not figure out what do next.

he should

should he

Either could be used here

In indirect questions, the auxiliary verb goes after the subject.

11. He asked me

to go

that I go

Ask can be followed by object + to-infinitive.

12. They made him for hours.

wait

waiting

to wait

Make + object is followed by infinitive without to.
