## Notes

The present perfect tense form is made with has / have + past participle form of the verb. Questions are made by putting has / have before the subject. Negative forms are made by putting not after has / have.

He has returned the parcel. (Affirmative)

He has not returned the parcel. (Negative)

Has he returned the parcel? (Question)
